Meeting Notice: Bollard System Planned For Vail Village and Lionshead. February 17, 2022

TOV Town Council Evening Meeting: 6:00 p.m. February 21, 2023

The Town of Vail has contracted with a consultant to complete the design of the Vail Pedestrian Village Safety Project which includes the selection of and the design of approximately 70 bollards and or equivalent safety measures and barricades at various locations within the Vail Village, the Lionshead Village, and Ford Park. The purpose of this discussion is to confirm the project goals, review the initial concept, and identify initial concerns.

There are concerns that this could have an adverse effect upon residential owners in the Village/Lionshead cores and those in adjacent residential neighborhoods. These concerns are a result of impacts from earlier stages of the TOV effort to restrict vehicular access within portion of Vail Village. VHA recommends that additional public discussion with affected residential and commercial owners should occur, prior to making further decisions on this proposal.

TOV Staff Recommendation: Staff Recommends that the Council confirms the project goals and provide and additional input and or direction. See attached documents for additional information. Staff memo to Town Council and detailed presentation of the proposal.
