Those who haven't received a mail-in ballot can still vote at the polls on November 5th. You can register to vote in person at the [Eagle County Clerk & Recorder's](#) offices up to the day of the election. To verify if you are currently registered to vote, visit: <https://www.sos.state.co.us/Voter/secuVerifyExist.do>.

To be eligible to register to vote in Vail's municipal election you must be a U.S. citizen, 18 years of age or older and you must have established residency within the Town of Vail at least 22 days preceding the election.

Vail's Nov. 5 election is an at-the-polls format with all voting taking place at the Town of Vail Municipal Building, 75 S. Frontage Rd., from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. It is separate from the Eagle County election.
